BSF Building Works

The BSF build is scheduled to commence week beginning June 22nd 2009. At this initial stage, the builders will be preparing the site for the new Technology and Sixth form block – this will entail breaking a new entrance through via St Mary's Avenue for site traffic only. The building area, which will extend from St Mary's Avenue to the Music block covering the existing rugby field, tennis courts and grass floodlit practice area, will be fenced off for health and safety reasons during the whole of the building phase.

The new building site entrance from St Mary's Avenue will be adjacent to the existing gate with the result that the present entrance will be closed for the foreseeable future (until September 2010). However, in September this year, a new entrance in St Mary's Avenue will be positioned adjacent to the sub station and will provide access to the school via a temporary car park behind the sports hall.

Please note that during the initial phase of the build (June-September 2009), there will be only one vehicle entrance into school via the existing Lisle Road gate. Fortunately we have managed to retain a pedestrian entrance at both St Mary's Avenue and Lisle Road. However, students entering a new gate on St Mary's Avenue will have a longer walk around the playing fields in order to gain access to the school.
